This film documents the journey of a very brave Tibetan-Canadian woman, Kalsang Dolma, who successfully managed to visit Tibet and secretly show a short video of the Dalai Lama delivering his message to many Tibetans.

The film was shot between 1996 and 2004 as the video clip message was shown to many Tibetans from Buddhist priests to teenage passersby without the knowledge of the Chinese authorities.

As the interviewer, Kalsang recorded reactions as well as feelings told to her regarding Tibet's future and whether freedom can be achieved with a nonviolent approach.
